Sterile Ophthalmic Solution

Composition:

Each 1 ml of **Phenzomia** Ophthalmic Solution contains Naphazoline hydrochloride 0.25 mg, Pheniramine maleate 3 mg, and benzalkonium chloride 0.01% as preservative

Excipients:

Boric acid, edetate disodium, sodium borate, sodium chloride, Sodium Hydroxide and/or Hydrochloric acid QS to adjust pH, water for injection QS to 5 mL.

Indications:

Phenzomia ophthalmic solution is indicated for the temporary relief of redness and itching of the eye (eyes) caused by any allergen (pollen, grass, animal dander, ...)

Contraindications:

If you are sensitive to any ingredient in this product or this solution changes color or become cloudy.

Dosage:

<u>Adults and children 6 years and over:</u> 1 or 2 drops in the affected eye(s) up to 4 times daily <u>Children under 6 years:</u> ask a doctor

Warnings and precautions:

- For external use only
- Pupils may become enlarged temporarily causing light sensitivity
- Phenzomia ophthalmic solution should not be used if you are sensitive to any ingredient in this product, or if this solution changes color or becomes cloudy.
- A doctor should be consulted before using Phenzomia ophthalmic solution if the patient suffers from: narrow angle glaucoma, heart disease, high blood pressure, trouble urinating
- Phenzomia ophthalmic solution should be discontinued if eye pain, changes in vision occur, or redness or irritation of the eye(s) gets worse or lasts more than 72 hours.
- Contact lenses should be removed before using Phenzomia ophthalmic solution
- To prevent contamination of the solution, avoid contact of the drop head with any surface.
- Keep out of reach of children

Side Effects:

Side effect associated with the use of Phenzomia Ophthalmic Solution is pupils enlargment temporarily causing light sensitivity

Overdose:

- Overuse may cause more eye redness
- If the product is swallowed, get medical help immediately.
- Accidental swallowing of **Phenzomia** ophthalmic solution by infants and children may lead to coma and marked reduction in body temperature.

Storage conditions:

Store at (20-25)°C. Protected from light.

Packaging:

Phenzomia ophthalmic solution is supplied in polyethylene bottle 5mL with dropper, tightly sealed with a polyethylene closer within a carton box
